

**OSU Collegiate 4-H General Meeting  
April 16, 2008**

The April 16th meeting was called to order by President Joe Zimmerman at 7:30PM in Agricultural Engineering Building room 100. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Christy Clary and the 4-H Pledge was led by Marie Strouse.

Minutes from the last meeting were sent to all members through e-mail. There were no additions or corrections to the minutes and the Secretary's Report stands as posted. Kristen Corry gave a Treasurer's Report of a previous balance of \$2,014.40 and a current balance of \$2,815.13. The Treasurer's Report stood as read.

Education Officer Abby Keyt asked members to sign up for the remaining Educational Trips. The remaining trips are Delaware Co. April 17<sup>th</sup>, Wyandot Co. April 28<sup>th</sup>, and Wayne Co. May 5<sup>th</sup>. Christy Clary told members that the OMK Family Readiness Conference was a success during the Community Service report. Marie Strouse gave the CFAES Representative report. During the Social Officer report, given by Joe Zimmerman, members were asked to sign-up to bring food for the end of quarter potluck. Member at Large Shea McConahay reported that the club has received a Coke Grant of 75 drinks for the potluck and that the volleyball court at Fred Beakman Park has been reserved for the club also.

Marie Strouse made a motion for the club to reimburse herself for the purchase of the Speaker's Gift for the Buckeye Bake-Off. Megan Strahler seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Several announcements were made. Megan Strahler announced that Best Buddies is having a fundraiser at Cold Stone Creamery next Tuesday from Noon to 10:00PM. Executive Team members should stay after the meeting for a meeting. Garrison Fogt announced that his fraternity is having a fundraiser for the Run Against Cancer at Blue's BBQ every Tuesday of Spring Quarter. Shea McConahay announced that Golden Key is having a fundraiser May 22<sup>nd</sup> at the Little Bar. It was also announced that April 22<sup>nd</sup> has been designated as "The Best Day of Your Life" Day and there will be free items given away around campus. This event is to raise awareness about depression. No Advisor Comments were given.
