One \$2,000.00 scholarship will be awarded annually to a freshman/sophomore active member of Alpha Tau Zeta at The Ohio State University. The scholarship will be selected at the end of Spring Quarter for the following academic year. The recipient must have completed less than six quarters of full-time enrollment at the end of Spring Quarter with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0. The recipient will be selected by a committee designated by The Ohio State University and Alpha Tau Zeta Alumni Association trustees. The recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholarship, character, contribution to Townshend Alpha Tau Zeta, and contribution to and leadership in college and university activities. The award will be made in one-third increments at the beginning of Fall, Winter and Spring quarters through the Office of Student Financial Aid from the Claude Hummel ATZ Scholarship Fund.
