First Lt. Ruehle was killed in the service of his country April 11, 1967 near Bong Son, South Vietnam and the Medard A.J. Ruehle Memorial Award has been established to honor him. For 2007 - 2008, one \$2,000 award will be granted to a student in agriculture who has completed six or more quarters of college work by the end of Spring Quarter 2006 and who best portrays the same attributes of Medard--those of high scholarship, outstanding leadership, and fine character.
