

Visiting Scholar

Definition: Faculty members or researchers who come to OSU on a temporary basis to teach and/or conduct research. They usually have collaborative interests in research and may give lectures in a class but are not generally responsible for a course. Visiting Scholars may be compensated for their services, but it is not required. Persons holding this title are not eligible for tenure, may not vote at any level of governance, and may not participate in promotion and tenure matters.

Appointment: Appointments are made for the period in which the service is provided **not to exceed three continuous academic years of service**. Approval is required from the Department Chair and the Dean.

Initial appointment requires CV and letter of request from Chair and approval of Dean before entry into HRIS.

Position Data: Separate data required for each appointment

Position Description: Not required if uncompensated; compensated positions should have description submitted.

Type: TERM or TEMP

Pay Group: MO3 or MO1 (MO1 is benefits-eligible)

Length: 12/12 months
